Between August 23-25 the Graduate Program in Political Science will host a workshop on "The Politics of the new Right in Latin America." The papers to be presented at this online event are part of a book project sponsored by the Latin American Studies Association and the Ford Foundation (LASA Ford Special Projects Grant 2020). The book editors have invited a team of specialists on the politics of seven Latin American countries to produce 10 chapters on the trajectories of the political right in Latin America after the left turn of the 2000s. During the workshop, draft chapters will be analyzed and discussed by internationally renowned scholars in party politics and political behavior.

The event will start on Monday, August 23 with a session on conservative party-building, rebranding, and decay. It will then continue on Tuesday, August 24, analyzing political cleavages and the emergence of the new Right. The event will end on Wednesday, August 25 with a session on polarization and right-wing voters.
